Clothespin Creatures

Time:

• 5 minutes

Suggested Materials:

- Clothespins
- Dinosaur cut-outs
- Scissors

- Colored pencils
- Markers
- Glue Sticks

Instructions:

- 1. Color in a creature template (Hadrosaurus, Masotdon, or a template of your own creation)
- 2. Cut the template out
- 3. Cut along the horizontal line
- 4. Glue top and bottom parts of your template to a clothespin
- 5. Enjoy as a puppet or other fun toy!

Extra Information:

- Hadrosaurus (hadrosaurus foulkii)
 - o It's a duckbilled dinosaur
 - o Was about 25 ft. long, stood at 10 ft. tall
 - It is thought to have stood on its hind feet when running and to have used its front feet to support itself when grazing
 - o It had blunt teeth, which confirms that it was an herbivore
 - o Lived 80 million years ago during the late Cretaceous period
 - When it was discovered in 1858, it was the most complete dinosaur skeleton unearthed anywhere in the world
 - The hadrosaurus is the state fossil of New Jersey and was first discovered in Haddonfield
- Mastodon (Mammut)
 - o Appeared 27-30 million years ago
 - o Appeared primarily in North and Central America
 - o Slightly smaller than mammoths
 - o Was about 8-10 ft. tall
 - Went extinct around 10,000 years ago due climate change and/or human hunting


Clothespin Creatures Instructions
